| 1 | Table around 3x2 feet for Devsthapana with clean cotton cloth to cover it |
| 2 | Flowers for Decoration and for puja offerings |
| 3 | Water Bowls with spoons - 2 |
| 4 | Kumkum / Sandalwood powder - for puja |
| 5 | Kalash and (Shrifal) coconut with Shell |
| 6 | Incense sticks (Agarbatti) - 1 pack |
| 7 | Ghee – 250 gms |
| 8 | Light Lamp (Deepak) - 1 main, 5 for aarti |
| 9 | Kheer(Semi-solid) - for offering in Yagya as well as can be for Parsad |
| 10 | Aluminum foil - for covering yagya kund as well as flooring below it |
| 11 | Betel nut (supari) - 2 for puja, 1 for purnahuti (Final oblation) |
| 12 | Havan Samagri - powder for oblations (Ahutis) (Grocery stores generally have it) |
| 13 | Bowls for Havan samagri - 4 |
| 14 | Kalawa (Colored thread to be tied around the wrist) |
| 15 | Prasad - anything you like, fruits etc. |
| 16 | Paper Towel |
| 17 | Steel spoon and bowl for Ghee - 1 |
| 18 | Plate for keeping all puja items - 1 |
| 19 | Small Plate for Sarva-deva puja - 1 |
| 20 | Wood (Make sure its thin long pieces. Any natural low pollution wood should be okay.) |
| 21 | Rice - for puja |
| 22 | Matchstick / Lighter - 1 |
| 23 | Camphor (K Kapoor) - 1 box |
| 24 | Green Betle leaves (Nagarvel) – 6 for Kalash Sthapana {if available} |
| 25 | Havan Kund |
| 26 | Half Dry coconut |
| 27 | Cotton/ Cotton Swabs |
| 28 | Gayatri Mata's Photo or any God/Goddess photo |
| 29 | Small murti of lord Ganesh |
| 30 | Ganga Jal (in small quantaity) |
| 31 | Soil (in small quantity from your backyard) |
| 32 | Grass (in small quantity from your backyard) |
| 33 | Turmeric (single solid piece) |
| 34 | Coin (some loonies or toonies) |
