

<b>Kundi(fire) Yagya Item List</b>	
1	<b>Table around 3x2 feet</b> for Devsthapana with clean cotton cloth to cover it
2	<b>Flowers</b> for Decoration and for puja offerings
3	<b>Water Bowls with spoons</b> - 2
4	<b>Kumkum / Sandalwood powder</b> - for puja
5	<b>Kalash and (Shrifal) coconut with Shell</b>
6	<b>Incense sticks (Agarbatti)</b> - 1 pack
7	<b>Ghee</b> – 250 gms
8	<b>Light Lamp (Deepak)</b> - 1 main, 5 for aarti
9	<b>Kheer(Semi-solid)</b> - for offering in Yagya as well as can be for Parsad
10	<b>Aluminum foil</b> - for covering yagya kund as well as flooring below it
11	<b>Betel nut (supari)</b> - 2 for puja, 1 for purnahuti (Final oblation)
12	<b>Havan Samagri</b> - powder for oblations (Ahutis) (Grocery stores generally have it)
13	<b>Bowls</b> for Havan samagri - 4
14	<b>Kalawa</b> (Colored thread to be tied around the wrist)
15	<b>Prasad</b> - anything you like, fruits etc.
16	<b>Paper Towel</b>
17	<b>Steel spoon and bowl</b> for Ghee - 1
18	<b>Plate</b> for keeping all puja items - 1
19	<b>Small Plate</b> for Sarva-deva puja - 1
20	<b>Wood</b> (Make sure its thin long pieces. Any natural low pollution wood should be okay.)
21	<b>Rice</b> - for puja
22	<b>Matchstick / Lighter</b> - 1
23	<b>Camphor (K Kapoor)</b> - 1 box
24	<b>Green Betle leaves ( Nagarvel)</b> – 6 for Kalash Sthapana {if available}
25	<b>Havan Kund</b>
26	<b>Half Dry coconut</b>
27	<b>Cotton/ Cotton Swabs</b>
28	<b>Gayatri Mata's Photo or any God/Goddess photo</b>
29	<b>Small murti of lord Ganesh</b>
